Conditions of entry

1. Our beanie definition includes any beanie that is wearable, provides some warmth and is a handmade original!
2. Each beanie maker may enter two beanies into the Competition Exhibition. One beanie must be for sale, the second beanie can be for sale or not for sale.
3. Beanies must be received at the PO Box by Friday 19th July 2019. Beanies can also be delivered to Woodleigh School reception in Langwarrin South by Friday 19th July 2019.

4. Each entry must be delivered with:
 - a. A completed and signed entry form.
 - b. An identification label with the beanie artist's name, beanie title and price clearly marked and firmly stitched (not pinned) to the inside crown of the beanie.
 - c. A non-refundable entry fee of \$10 per beanie (students \$5).

- d. Artist statement/beanie story (optional). Please send an artist statement with your work in a one page A4 format or a story about your beanie or about making it. This will be placed in the exhibition space.
5. All entries will be seen by the judges and the judges will decide the categories for each entry.
6. A 50% commission will be taken from the asking price. Please consider all your costs – materials, entry fees, commission, postage, effort etc. If you would like to donate your entire asking price to Woodleigh School's Indigenous community partnerships, please tick the box on the entry form.
7. Payment for sold beanies will be made directly into your bank account by 9th August 2019. Please provide your bank details on the entry form.
8. Whilst all care will be taken with the entries, no responsibility will be accepted for lost or damaged beanies by the Woodleigh Beanie Festival. Insurance remains the responsibility of the artist.
9. The Woodleigh Beanie Festival reserves the right to use images of the works entered free of charge for any promotion or publication. Apart from this, copyright resides with the entrant.
10. All unsold beanies can be returned to the artist or can be donated to the Ampilatwatja community in the Northern Territory or a local charity of Woodleigh School's choice. Please tick the box on the entry form.

Competition Categories

1. Reconciliation beanie

For a beanie that expresses an aspect of the 2019 National Reconciliation Week theme "Grounded in truth: walk together with courage".

2. Respect beanie

For a beanie that celebrates Woodleigh's values – respect for self, respect for others and respect for the environment.

3. Sustainable beanie

For a beanie made with recycled materials and/or the spirit of environmental sustainability at its heart – reduce, reuse and recycle. Strive to reduce our impact on the natural environment.

4. Natural fibres beanie

For a fabulous beanie made from a love of natural fibres.

5. Local inspiration beanie

For a beanie inspired by our beautiful Mornington Peninsula.

6. International beanie

For a beanie with an international flavour. Will it be a beret, fez or sombrero??

7. Animal beanie

Are you a big animal lover? Then this is the category for you! Create your very own animal beanie.

8. Wear around a campfire beanie

For a warm and cosy beanie you would wear around a campfire.

9. Peace beanie

A beanie to inspire contemplation and peace in this busy world.

10. Loudest beanie

For a beanie that invites interaction and fun! Whether it be colour, texture or sound, something to blow the senses away!

11. Collaborative beanie

For a beanie produced by two or more people working together.

12. Minimbah prize

A prize for a beanie maker from Minimbah who has created a masterpiece.

13. Penbank prize

A prize for a beanie maker from Penbank who has created a masterpiece.

14. Woodleigh prize

A prize for a beanie maker from the Woodleigh campus who has created a masterpiece.

15. People's choice prize

For the beanie voted most popular at the festival.

All beanies will be judged in all categories.
